NOTICE TO ALL UNIT OWNERS HURRICANE PREPAREDNESS UPDATED ON MAY 31, 2022

Tomorrow is the first day of Hurricane season - the season officially starts on June 1 and runs through November 30th. However, this is not an exact predictor of timeline for storms. The first hurricane of the season made landfall in southern Mexico over the weekend as a Category 2 storm. Although unlikely, there is a possibility that the remnants of this storm will gain strength while in the Gulf of Mexico and affect South Florida. As with all storms of this nature, it is extremely difficult to forecast the exact path and strength of the storm - that is one reason why the Hurricane Center and other storm related organizations use the "cone" method to indicate the possibility of a storm coming into our area.

This is a reminder that now is not too soon to prepare for a storm. There are preparedness checklists posted on our website and available in the office. Publix makes available an excellent guide called "Ready for the hurricane. ready for anything." We have several copies of it for your taking, at the office. In addition, checklists and additional information is being handed out to our residents by you, our Directors and was emailed to those who have opted-in for electronic notification last week.
